This bursary has been established to offer financial assistance to women, as the Society seeks to support applicants both practically and emotionally, and to foster personal growth and empowerment.

The purpose of the Kamloops Elizabeth Fry Women's Educational Bursary is to offer financial assistance to women, 18 years and older, who are moving to enhance their economic independence and self-sufficiency. **The bursary will be awarded to a Canadian citizen or permanent resident who will be attending a recognized Canadian College, trades school, or university.** Any program will be considered, with the ultimate goal of obtaining a certificate, diploma and/or a degree. Current or past clients of Elizabeth Fry are encouraged to apply.

Applicants are requested to fill out the attached application form and provide all the information required. Please ensure that all necessary documentation is completed, signed and that all supporting material is enclosed (copies are acceptable as applications will not be returned).

Applications will be accepted from **February 15, 2020 to April 01, 2020.**
Late, unsigned or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
